Technical Requirements for the EP

- General: In line with the national requirements
 - DSRC CEN TC 278 and EN 15509 transaction
 - White List and Black List
 - Key performance indicators similar to national system, to maintain the high standard of the national system
 - Execution of the complete customer service by EP
 - Service hotline for the EP
 - Non disclosure of toll dodgers data leads to EP liability for the fine

Commercial Conditions for the EP

- Fees:
 - Fixed fee to cover ASFINAG implementation costs
 - Fixed fee to cover ASFINAG OBU test costs
- Reimbursement:
 - Disagio for each toll transaction
- Bank guarantee
 - Coverage of implementation costs during implementation phase
 - 10 % of annual turnover during operation phase
- All future changes on its own cost

Registration Procedure (main steps)

1. Application at ASFINAG
2. Evidence of registration as EP and of its intention for application in all EETS countries
3. Lol between ASFINAG and EP candidate
4. Technical and commercial concept of EP
5. Check of plausibility of concept by ASFINAG
6. Issuing of bank guarantee I
7. Commercial negotiations

Registration Procedure II (main steps)

7. Conclusion of contact
8. Suitability for use test incl. trail operation (OBU need EETS certification)
9. Issuing of bank guarantee II
10. Start of EETS operation by EP

Note:

Cancellation of contract if EP fails to reach EETS Status (i.e. stop performance of the EETS service within one Toll Domain for more than 6 month)
