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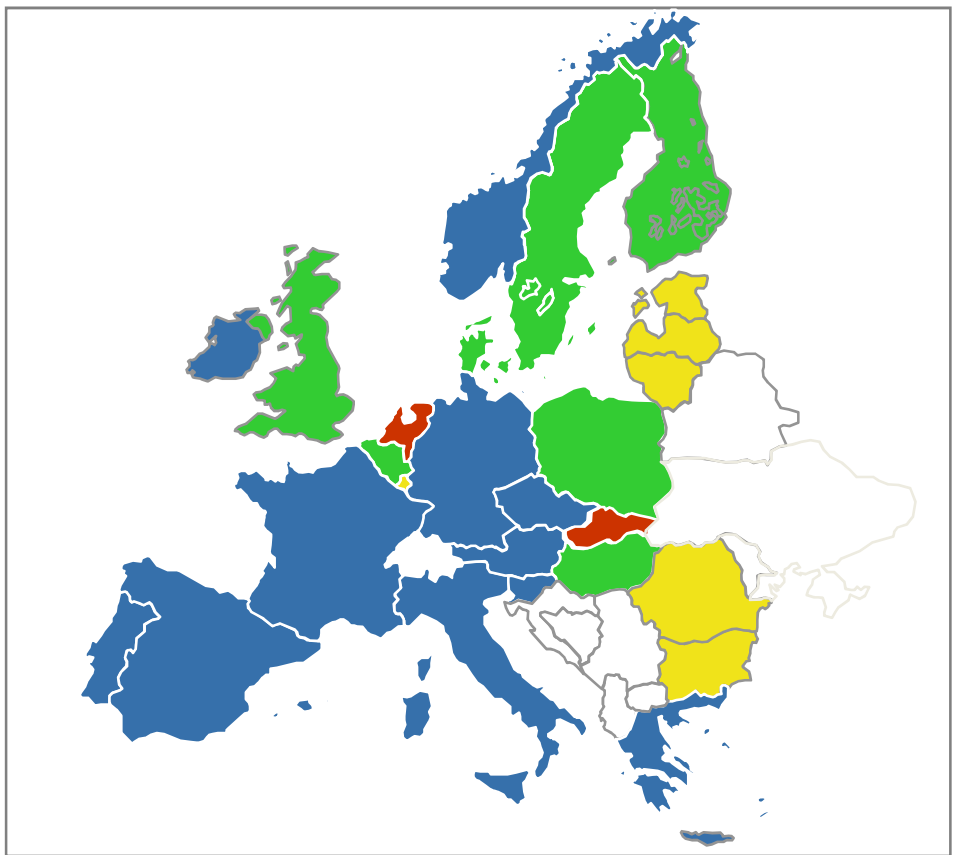

Access to Toll Domains

- **EETS Domain Statement**

- EETS Domain Statement is crucial for specifying the access of EETS Providers to the national system
- High quality of service level required based on principles of the German operator contract
- Relevance for acceptance and remuneration
- Exchange of aggregated data only (requirement for EETS Providers' back office)



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EETS-Architecture

- **EETS architecture is crucial**

- to specify the access of EETS Providers
- to achieve interoperability between stakeholders

- **EETS specifications are crucial**

- to define the EETS Domain Statement
- to reduce costs
